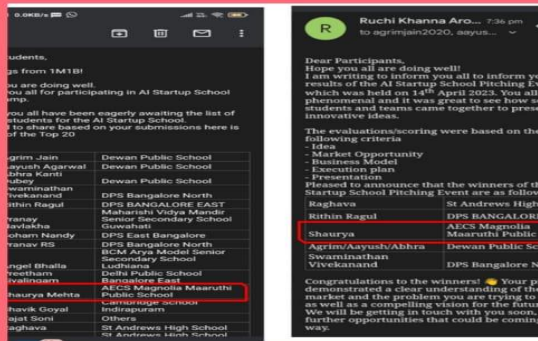
Swimming Competition
